

## *How to Transfer Your Cengage Learning PTR ebook From Your Computer to Your iPhone*

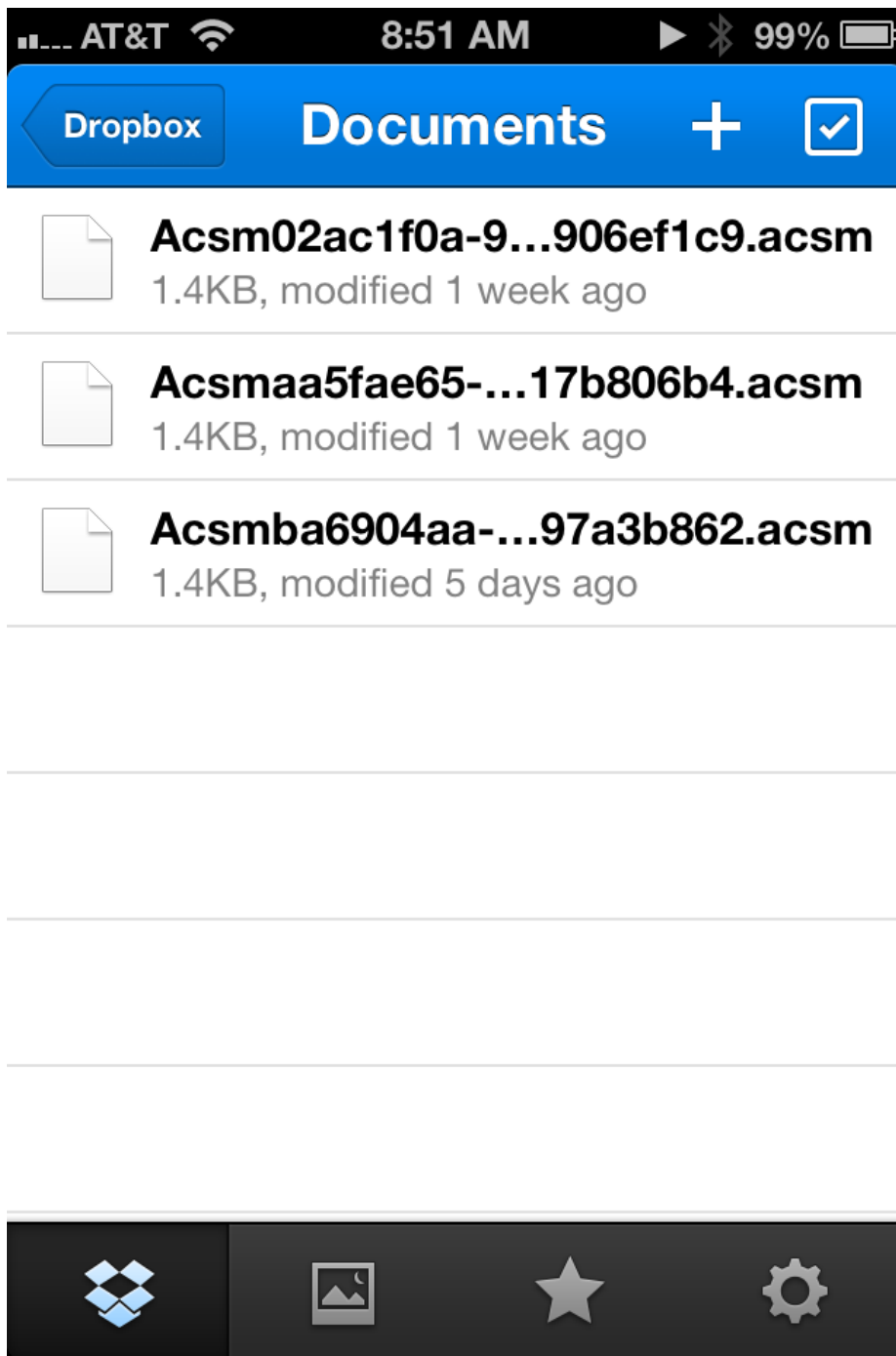
Before you begin, make sure you have:

- A registered Adobe ID with adobe.com (you can get one (you can get one [here](#))
- Adobe Digital Editions on your computer (download here: <http://www.adobe.com/products/digital-editions.html>)
- A registered DropBox account and the DropBox app downloaded to your mobile device
- Downloaded the BlueFire app for your mobile device
- Have purchased your ebook and it has been downloaded to your computer

1. First, drag and drop the eBook authentication file to your DropBox on your computer:



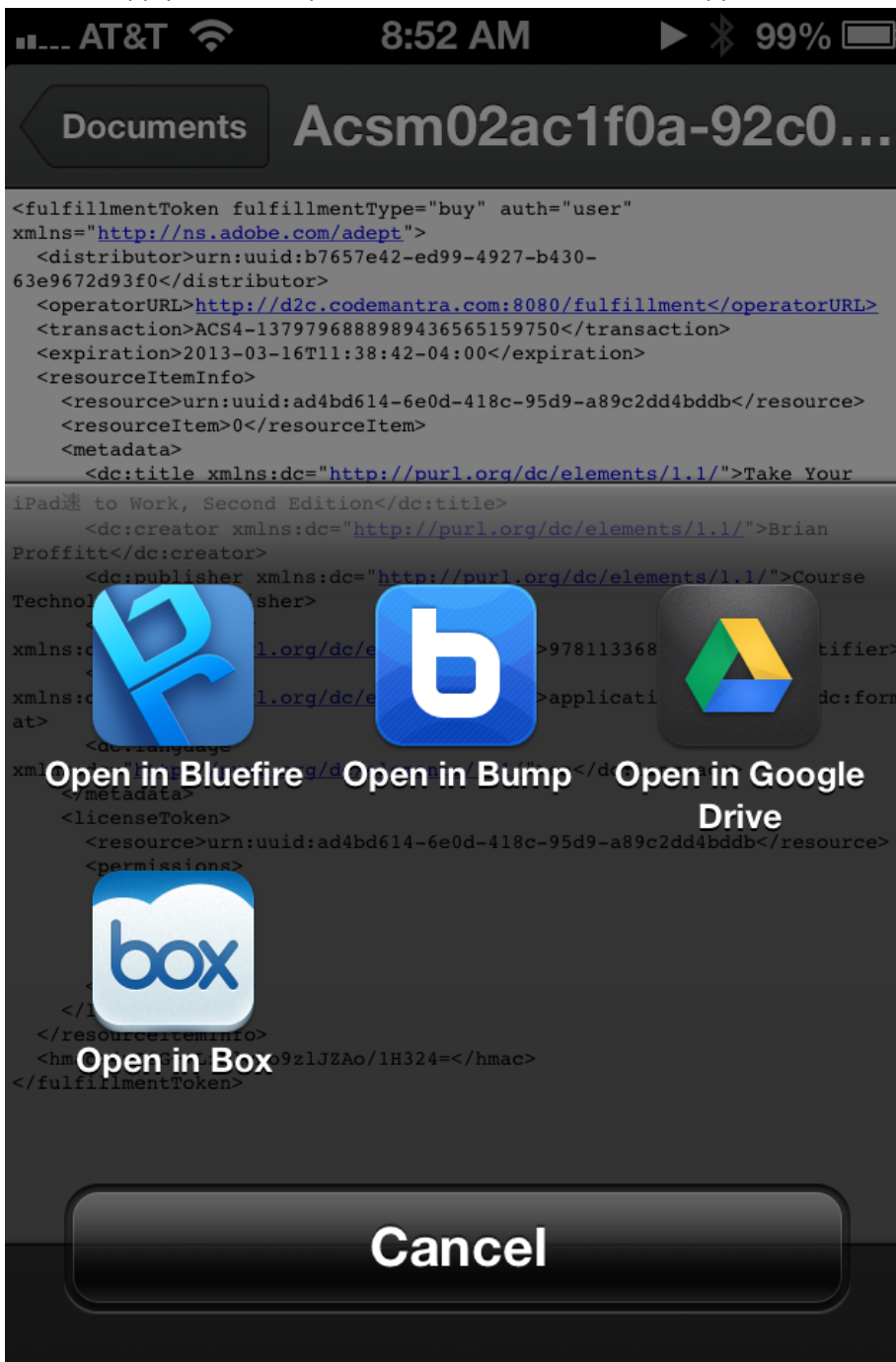
2. Next, go to the location in DropBox on your iPad and locate the same eBook authentication file:



3. Select your email and view the authentication file:



4. Click on the lower right hand corner icon (the down arrow). This will provide some choices as to which app you use to open the file. Select the BlueFire App:



5. The BlueFire app will open



6. And will then prompt you to enter Your Adobe ID and password.

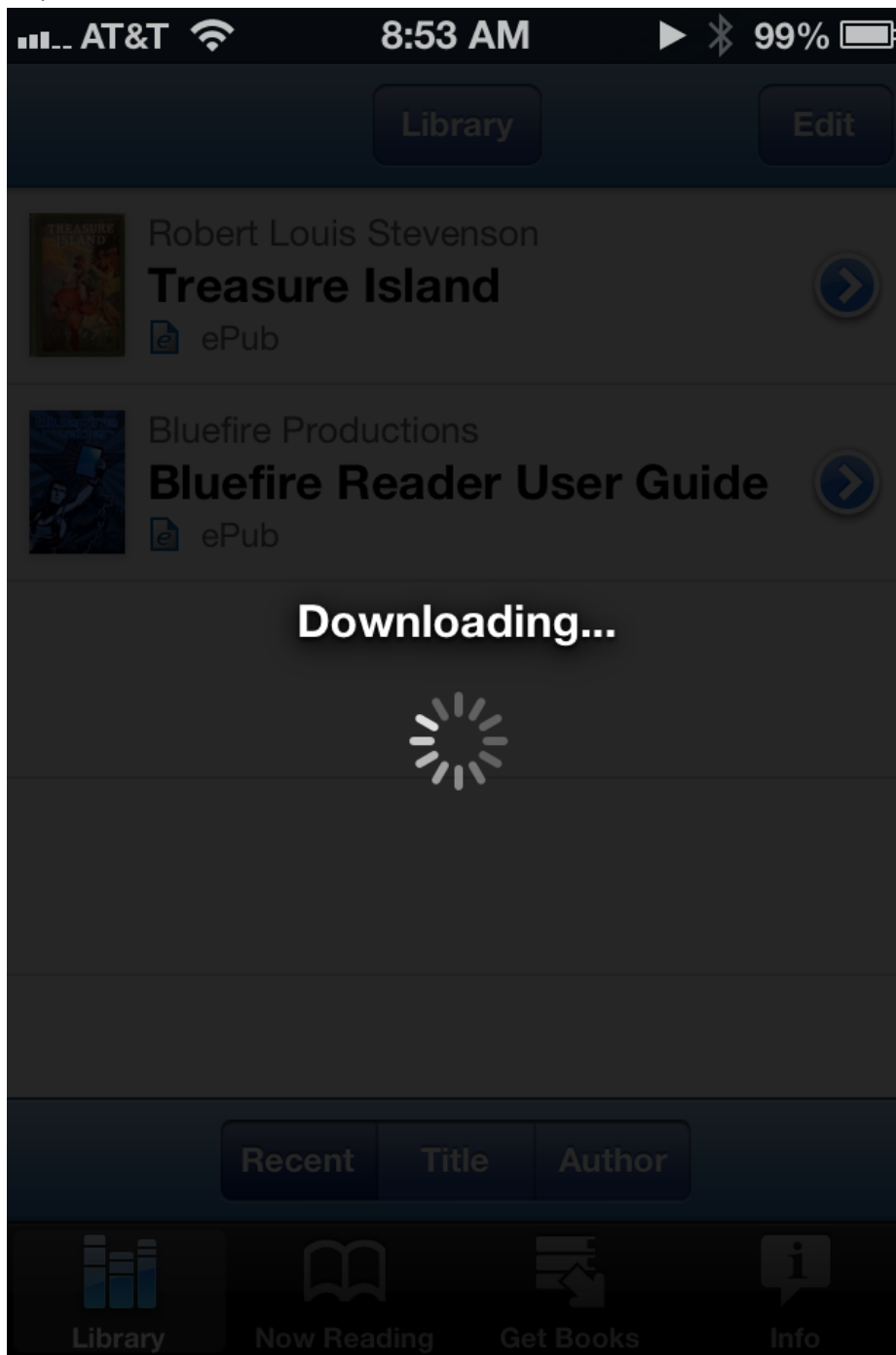

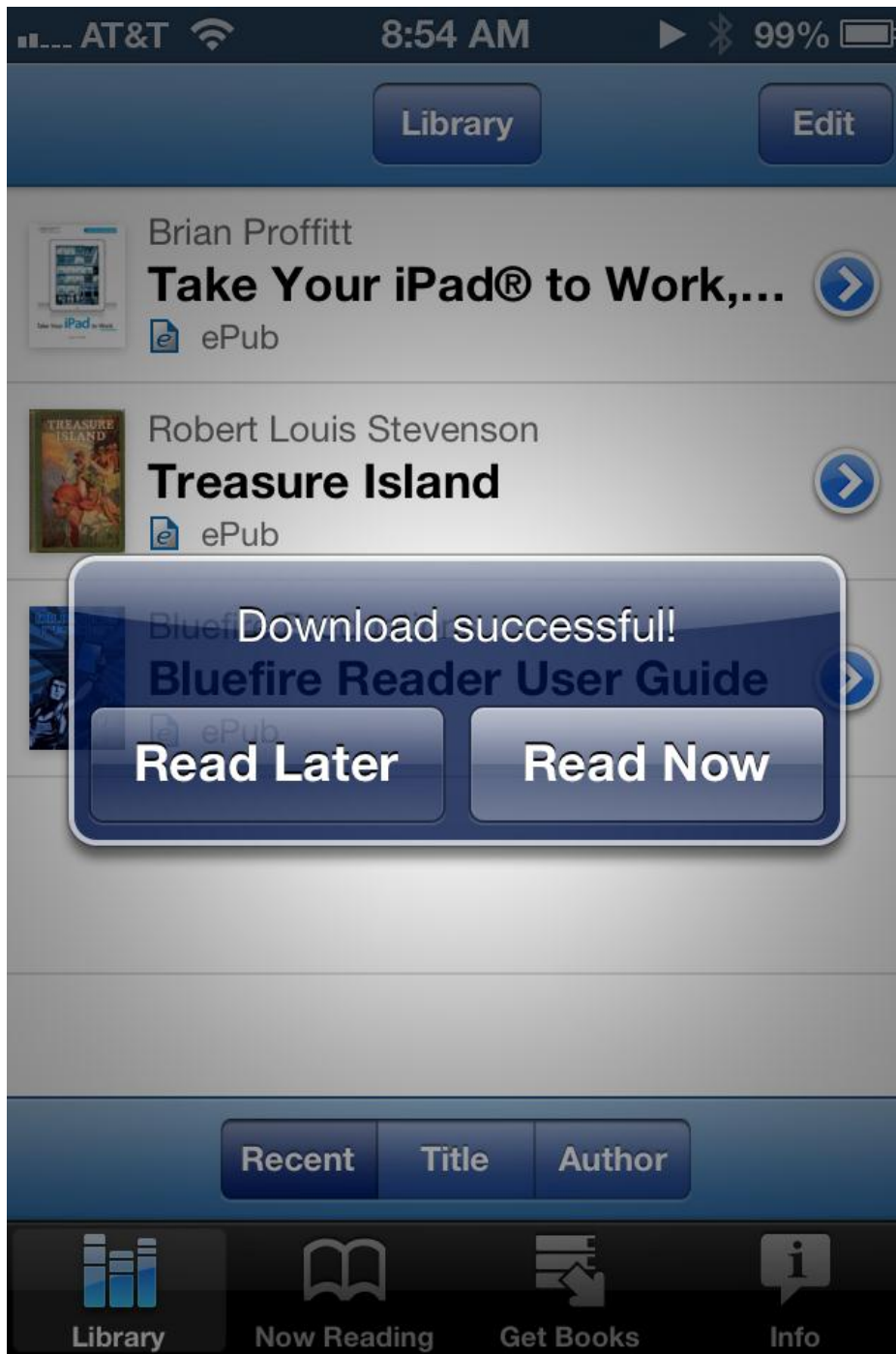
